### Sunshine Quilters of San Diego Board Meeting August 25, 2020

Attendance: Kathy Barnes, Kathy Manuel, Lorna Bisson, Connie Smith, Candi Ravenscraft, Christy Sprecco, Beth Van Gelder, Jean Zuniga, Peggy Jencks

Meetings: Our goal is to keep the guild going. Options were discussed - Renette Center outside, someone's house/yard if big enough, cancel meetings altogether. It was decided to use Zoom to hold meetings. Christie Sprecco has an account and offered send out links for on-line training and to hold training sessions for members to get comfortable with this venue.

Monthly BOM: Lorna Bisson volunteered to coordinate this. Proposed way of handling this will be to have the pattern in the newsletter, show the block at the Zoom meeting, save blocks until we

have an actual meeting to have a drawing and giveaway.

Seasonal Opportunity Quilt: We'll try to do the same with this; people will sign up to create but hold on to them until the actual in-person meeting.

Show 'n Tell: Pictures of projects can be sent in, a slide show will be created, and members can tell

about their quilts.

Projected 2020/2021 budget: The budget was presented by Connie Smith and discussed. With income and expenses mostly unknown due to the quarantine circumstances, the estimated expenses are greater than income. This is permissible by State ruling as long as our reserves can cover the difference. The Board agreed that spending into our reserve during this unusual time may be required in order to maintain our guild. Kathy Barnes will check with the Rec Center received or prorated costs for the room.

Membership: The board agreed that membership dues would remain the same. The membership form will be mailed to members and they will be asked to mail the form and a check to the PO

Box and Connie Smith will collect.

Annual Opportunity Quilt: \$20 of the \$50 membership dues will be for tickets for the Annual Opportunity Quilt that members can sell. A flyer will be published to assist members in selling tickets.

**Fundraising:** No auctions are planned at this time. Further discussions needed to see if we will be able to participate in the Summers Past Craft Fair.

Advertisement: Christy Sprecco is contacting previous and potential advertisers.

Speakers: Poll results were reviewed, and Kathy Manual will present at the September meeting. The speakers that have been set up will be contacted to see if they are still teaching and if they will be able to accommodate Zoom meetings. Beth Van Gelder will contact future potential speakers> She has noticed from speaker's websites that most will be able to accommodate Zoom or have their own website venue to classes. Will work with teachers/speakers for best venue to have workshops. To encourage membership renewal, it was agreed that the first workshop will be offered for free to all members. Also discussed possibility of offering workshop slots to non-quild members.

# **ZOOMing**

# Into 2020-2021 By Christy Sprecco

Well it's clear we can't meet in person for a while, but Kathy Manual and Beth Van Gelder have such great meetings planned so it's a shame to postpone anymore. I don't know about the rest of you- but I miss our gatherings, and most especially the speaker & sharing portion.

In comes Zoom. By now many of you have likely been using some kind of video conferencing tool, whether it's facetime, FB Messenger, Zoom, Teams, etc. to connect with friends and loved ones. Zoom is a tool that many people have gotten to know, and it works well for the kinds of meetings we have.

Joining a meeting is as simple as clicking on the link that you will receive in an email. You can join from a computer, tablet or your phone. The first time you join from a computer, you may have to click to allow a file download – it's a simple plug in for your Internet browser. Then you'll be prompted to enter your name – please type your first and last name so we know who attended.

Once you're joined, you can turn on your video (or don't if you prefer not to). If your computer doesn't have video that's ok. If you find you are not hearing anyone speaking, try clicking on the audio option at the bottom of the screen to see if you need to chance audio source (speakers, headset etc.). If worse comes to worse, you can also dial in on the number provided from your phone so you can watch from computer (or tablet) but listen on your phone.

During the speaker presentations I will mute the audience, so we don't get background noise. When the speaker is ready for questions, I'll show you how to "raise your hand" so we know to unmute you for a question.

We've decided to try to have our sharing session via Zoom as well. Would ask that you email me a picture of your quilt (<a href="mailto:christyquilting@gmail.com">christyquilting@gmail.com</a>) in advance of the meeting, by day before please. I will put them all into a slide show, and then during the sharing session, I'll unmute the person sharing so you can share the details you would normally share at the meeting when your quilt is on the screen. If you don't think you can speak (equipment issues) you can also send me the narrative and I'll announce for you. I'm more than happy to help anyone in advance that would like to have a practice session. Just call or email me and I'll set something up.

Until we can meet in person, I wanted to provide helpful info on using ZOOM for our monthly meeting. If you have never used Zoom before, I'd encourage you to watch these 3 (short) videos for an overview:
