


Sunshine Quilters of San Diego meets the second Tuesday of each month (Sept-June) at Renette Park at 935 South Emerald Ave., El Cajon

Sunshine Quilters 2022/23 CHALLENGE FINALE

~~ THIS IS IT!! ~~

Our Paint Chip Challenge projects are due THIS NEXT meeting, Tuesday, May 9, 2023!!

Bring your completed project (based on the teal colored paint chip from Home Depots' Glidden paint display) to Tuesday's meeting with these guidelines in mind:

<u>Completed</u> and ready to be displayed: Either with a hanging sleeve, on a hanger (if a wearable project) or permissible to use a pin or two for displaying.

Contained in an unidentified bag.

Come to my table and I will give you a number.

- **You** will then attach your number to the upper right hand corner of your project.
- Then place your project back in your bag (with the number attached to your project) and place the bag in a basket which will be in the chair closet.

OUR CHALLENGE RULES ARE:

You must use three or more colors from my chosen paint chip – example on the right.

You may choose to use ONE other color ONLY. But this extra color is not required

We do not consider black, grey or white a color, so you may use any number of black to white hues in your quilt. However, they must be pure – no hint of a color in your grays – even of the one extra color you may use.

Your quilt (or fabric project) must be 18" square or larger.

Your quilt must be finished and ready for judging at the May 9, 2023 guild meeting.

Your time is nearly up!

Get those last bindings on and let's see what we've all created!!






