



## Sunshine Quilters UFO Club 2024-2025

A UFO can be any sewing, quilting, knitting, crocheting, painting, etc. project that you started but got put on the back burner and you didn't finish it. We do allow finished tops that you plan to pass on to Cuddle Quilts for others to quilt to count as a finished UFO. However, since quilting and binding a quilt often takes so much longer than making a top, 3 unfinished tops will count as one UFO entry. A maximum of 3 entries will be allowed per monthly drawing. Confused??? Here are some examples:

You finish 3 quilts and crocheted a blanket: you are allowed 3 entries into the drawing. You finish 6 Cuddle Quilt tops: you are allowed 2 entries into the drawing. You finish 3 Cuddle Quilt tops plus 2 quilts: you are allowed 3 entries into the drawing.

Join the UFO Club for \$10. Each month will be a drawing for \$10.

Each month, members have the opportunity to grow their 'stash' by participating in a fun exchange of fat quarter fabric. The drawing will be held at the meeting.

#### What is a Fat Quarter?

A fat quarter of fabric is a one-fourth yard cut measuring 18" x 22". To create a fat quarter, cut a half yard of fabric, 18" along the fabric's lengthwise grain, then cut that piece in half at its midpoint. Or you can purchase precuts. Fat quarter fabric should be 100% cotton quilt-shop quality.

#### **Guidelines for Fat Quarter Drawing**

- Bring a fat quarter that coordinates with that month's theme.
- Turn in your fat quarter at the Fat Quarter Basket at the Welcome table.
- Your name will be entered once in the drawing.
- The drawing will be held during the meeting.
- If your name is drawn you win the fat quarters.

TIP: If you are participating in the Fat Quarter Drawing, and do not like a particular color theme for the month, don't add your name to the basket. We want everyone to be happy with the fat quarters they win.



## Sunshine Quilters of San Diego Calendar, Speakers and Workshops 2024 – 2025

**September 10, 2024 Lecture: Jeff Warner** will be presenting "The Shape of Bargello." (Wikipedia explains that Bargello is a type of needlework laid in a mathematical pattern to create motifs. It usually uses many hues of one color, producing intricate shading effects and is naturally geometric.)

Jeff Warner grew up in the City of Orange and has been sewing for 38 years. Entirely self-taught, he began by taking his clothes apart and using the pieces as patterns on new fabric. In 1991, he caught the quilt bug, and turned his attention away from clothing and into quilt making. Jeff has worked as a theatrical lighting designer since the early nineties and has used his sewing skills to create scenery and set decoration for the stage. In 2002, he changed gears and began creating custom leather clothing, bags and accessories under the label L2Leather. In 2013, he came back to quilting with new ideas for an old style. Jeff specializes in Bargello quilts and has published two patterns featuring his Kaleidoscope Bargello style.

#### September 14, 2024 Workshop: Jeff Warner's Kaleidoscope Bargello



We will be using Jeff's block-based Kaleidoscope Bargello pattern.

The 18 1/2" hexagon block is made from six (6) identical Triangular-ish blocks of Bargello piecing. We'll make one (1) hexagon block as a placemat or a candle mat. Multiple blocks can be used to create a table runner, a lap quilt or a bed-sized quilt.

**October 8, 2024 Ice Cream Social:** (changed from September due to speaker, Jeff's availability.) Our new president, Jo Miller, will share a few words and present This year's board. We'll hear what exciting programs and opportunities are in store for us this year from our new committee chair<u>women.</u>

November 12, 2024 Lecture: Comedian Katsy Chappell will entertain us for the evening's "lecture!"

**December 10, 2024 Potluck night!** Our advertisers will have displays and there's a possibility of an auction and/or other items for sale.



**January 14, 2025 Lecture:** Peter Chang, new owner of Cozy Creative Center, will talk about his adventures on becoming a quilt store owner – and possibly bringing a special guest with him.

**January 18, 2025 FEATHERWEIGHT MAINTENANCE Workshop: Tom Griesgraber** an expert Featherweight technician will show us how to care for and maintain our individual Featherweight machines. Tom will be available from 10-2 and afterward we can work on our own projects using our newly adjusted machines.

**February 11, 2025 Lecture: Pam Davis** - our very own Pam Davis will present a trunk show featuring her Kim Diehl quilts and share some inside secrets.

**March 11, 2025 Lecture:** Sue Bouchard has been sewing since she was four and quilting since she was twelve. She loves to design and make modern quilts which are influenced by traditional designs. Her passion is teaching and inspiring others. Sue has taught at many Quilt Guilds, International Festivals and Craftours throughout the world. She'll share with you her journey and insights discovered by finding solace in her sewing room. Explore ways to combine styles, techniques and colors to create your own one-of-a-kind quilts. Special emphasis is the use of directional fabrics for effective design elements. Over 35 samples will inspire you!

#### March 15, 2025: Workshop: "Moon Dance" by Sue Bouchard



Combining Triangle in a Square patches with Pieced Triangle Squares gives the illusion of curves without any curved piecing. The Stars are brought together with Quarter Square patches. Your patchwork will dance across the Background!

Kits - 60 includes all fabrics, pattern and templates to complete the quilt top including the Binding.  $32" \times 42"$ 

**April 8, 2025 Lecture:** Christy Sprecco – our very own Christy Sprecco will share her quilting journey and show generational quilts along with some of her own.
